Lunar New Year "Say No to Gambling" Campaign



Sunday School Class - "Don't be greedy!"

The Lunar New Year is a very happy festival for children, because they would receive red packets from elderly people and got sweet candies as gifts during the festival. Lunar New Year is also a festival when the Chinese people pay special attention to wealth and luck. There is a custom of welcoming the "God of Wealth" and a tradition of good wishes to each other on getting rich. In some Chinese families, they will get together to engage in gambling activities as entertainment games.

In the past, the main job of CCGR was to help people who were trapped by gambling to get rid of their gambling addiction. Recently, we felt that the gambling problem in society has become younger. In order to prevent young people and children from being harmed by gambling, our center has tried to provide some Sunday school curriculum materials and start with education to achieve the purpose of preventing problems before occurred. Although children may not engage in gambling behavior, greedy is often to drive people to participate in activities that could reap without sowing, and as well as wanting to gain much money by luck. Therefore, we chose "Don't be greedy!" as the subject of the lesson. When children are receiving the wrong message about Lunar New Year festival, it can provide them with an opportunity of contemplation, correct mistakes in a timely manner, understand and establish biblical principles and values.
