During Lunar New Year, there was gambling habit within Chinese society commonly. Each family was sitting together for dinner and as customs elderly people give lucky money to the younger ones. Until midnight, fireworks were set off and the ghosts were driven away. The next day, the first day of Lunar New Year, people can go out to visit relatives and friends for New Year greetings. Do you think there was a similar custom in Old Testament of Bible?

About 3,300 years ago, the LORD's spoke to Israelites who were living as slaves in Egypt: "I had seen your suffering, your crying, and your tough experience. I would send Moses to rescue you from the oppression of the Egyptian and would lead you to the richness and wonderful land in Canaan. He told people to prepare an one-year-old lamb without blemish on the tenth day of the first lunar month, and on the fourteenth day, killed the lamb and put its blood at the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses in which they made unleavened bread. roasted meat and ate them all on that night. After the whole family had dinner together, they quickly put on their sandals, girded their belts, held their sticks in hand, and were ready to leave the house..., while God sent the plague to kill all the firstborn in Egypt, except the home having the sign of blood at the door frame, which were the Jewish family.

At that moment, the whole Egypt was filled with cries, and over 2 million Israelites fled from Egypt! Under the leadership of the Lord through Moses and Aaron, they began to go into the wilderness and towards the land of Canaan. In Jews society, the evening of the fourteenth day of the first lunar month is called Passover, it is also the day of God's redemption. About 2,000 years ago, Jesus Christ sacrificed His life with His blood to save all races and peoples. He was the sacrificed lamb in Passover.
